Pampa de Burro is 4000 hectare a reserve started by the community of Yambrasbamba; NPC's main research area. This area has a very high density of yellow-tailed woolly monkeys, making it a vital asset to the species' survival. It is also home to the endemic long whiskered owl as well as many other endemic bird species. This area will be a private conservation area, with the conditions and duration of the reserve being determined by the villagers themselves.

Sun Angel's Gardens:

Sun Angel's Gardens (Jardines Angel del Sol) is a 7418.7 hectare reserve started by a group of local farmers, La Asociacion de Productores Agropecuarias La Primavera (APALP), in the village of La Primavera. The reserve is between 950 – 2400 meters above sea level, a range that allows for a large variety of species, many of which endemic and/or endangered. With the help of NPC, APALP is aiming to make this area a concession for conservation which will make it a governmentally owned conservation area for the next 40 years.
